Excellent Academic Results

English 2019

- **8%** of students achieved a **H1**. The national average is **2%**.
- 17% of students achieved a H2. The national average is
 7%.
- 64% of students achieved between H1 and H4. The national average is 45%.

Our results - Maths

- This year, we are really proud of the fact that 43% of our students sat the higher level exam paper at Leaving Cert. This compares with only 33% nationally.
- Of those HL students, all of them achieved their 25 bonus points and 60% of our higher level students attained more than 70%.


Our results 2019

Engineering: In 2019- 89% of our students achieved H4 or above with 17% of our students getting a H1 compared to only 4% nationally.

Home Economics Leaving Cert-63% of our students achieved H3 or higher compared to 45% nationally.

Physics: In 2019 20% of our Physics students received a H1. The national average was 9%.

Leaving Cert. Results 2019



- 51% of our students achieved over 400 points compared to 37.4% nationally
- 20% of our students achieved over 500 points compared with 13% nationally
- 3.4 % achieved over 600 points compared with 1.4% nationally


League Table 2019 and 2020 Published by the Sunday Times News paper

- St Anne's ranked at 147 out of over 700 post primary schools nationwide.
- This places us in the top 20% of schools nationwide topping all neighbouring schools.

Progression to 3rd Level

- This is not the only way we rate success as it does not reflect the whole picture
- We believe in helping each student find an appropriate path for them to reach their individual potential be that an apprenticeship, a degree or a post leaving cert course
- Over 80% progress to a CAO course each year
- Majority go to UL or LIT
- Many go on to Post Leaving Cert Courses in LCFE






