St Anne's Community College, Killaloe will have an ASD class with 6 places available in the 2021/2022 academic year. As the ASD class was sanctioned after the closing date for applications to 1st year 2021/2022, a separate enrolment process will be held for this class.

- All applicants will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by Friday 12/3/21.
- Students who are offered a place in the class are required to formally accept the offer by completing and returning the Acceptance Form by Friday 26/3/21.

Please note that all applications must be accompanied by a professional report with an ASD diagnosis which states that the student requires a special class placement.

In the event of oversubscription, the following criteria will apply:

- If the student is currently enrolled in the school
- If the student has siblings currently enrolled in the school
- If the student has siblings who were previously enrolled in the school
- If the student is attending one of St Anne's feeder primary schools*
- If the student has just moved in to the locality of the school
- All other applicants

DATA PROTECTION

The Board of Management of St Anne's Community College is a committee of the Limerick and Clare Education and Training Board (LCETB), which is a data controller under the General Data Protection Regulations and the Data Protection Acts 1988 - 2018.
